To make an image bigger make sure the correct layer is clicked and then

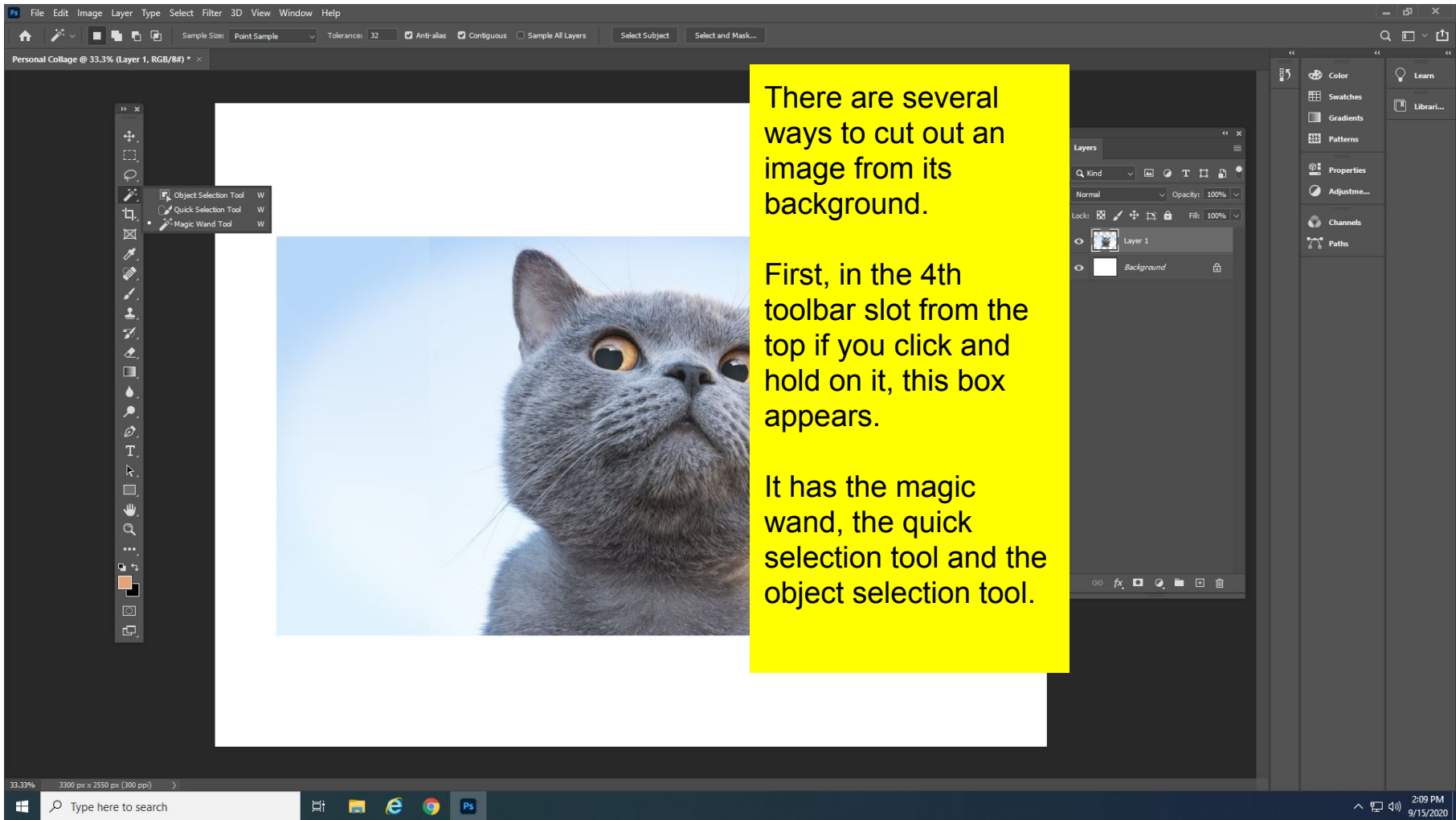
Edit > Transform > Scale

Layers panel showing 'Layer 1' and 'Background' layers. The 'Background' layer is selected. The panel includes options for Lock, Fill, and Opacity.

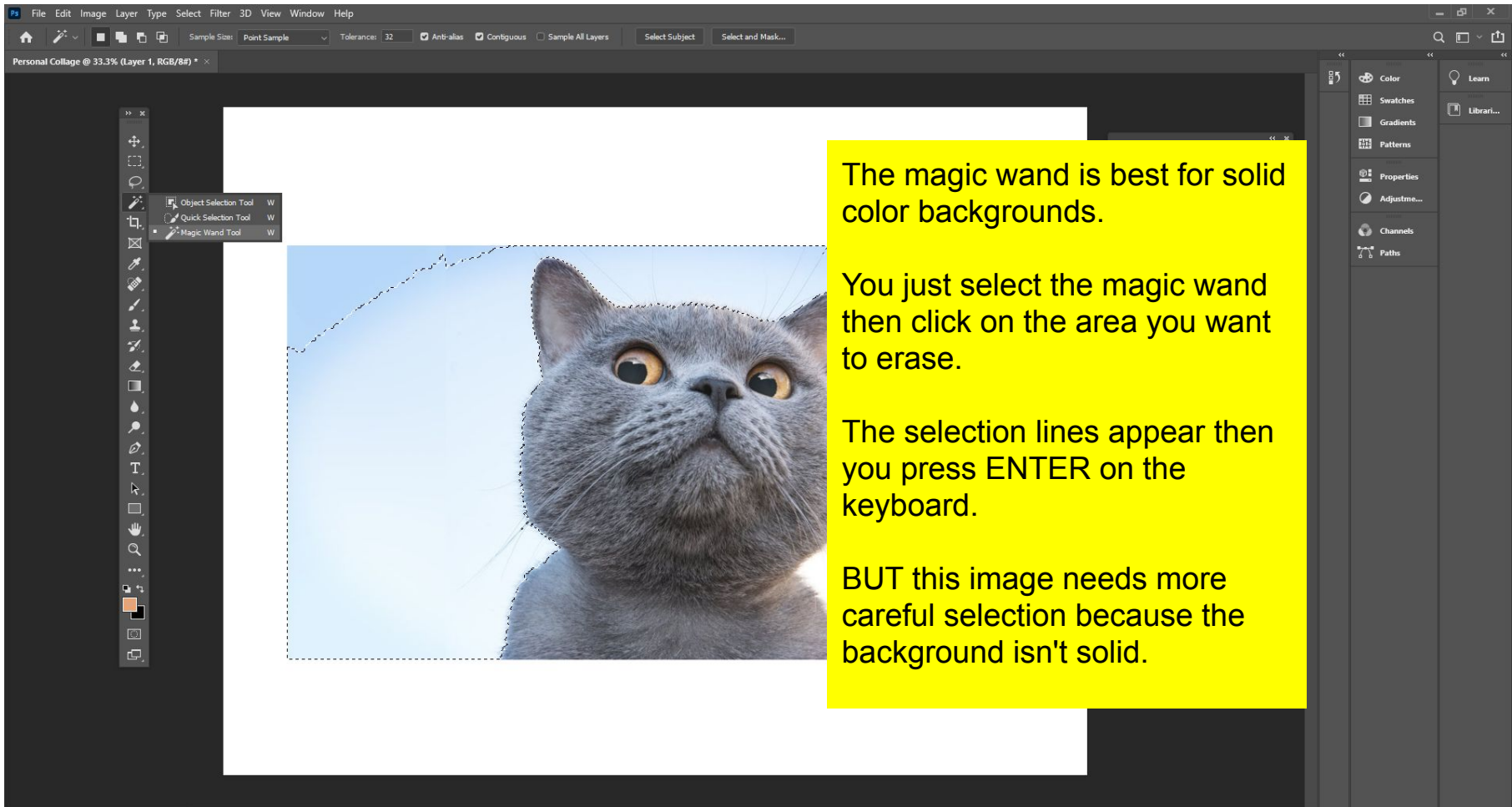

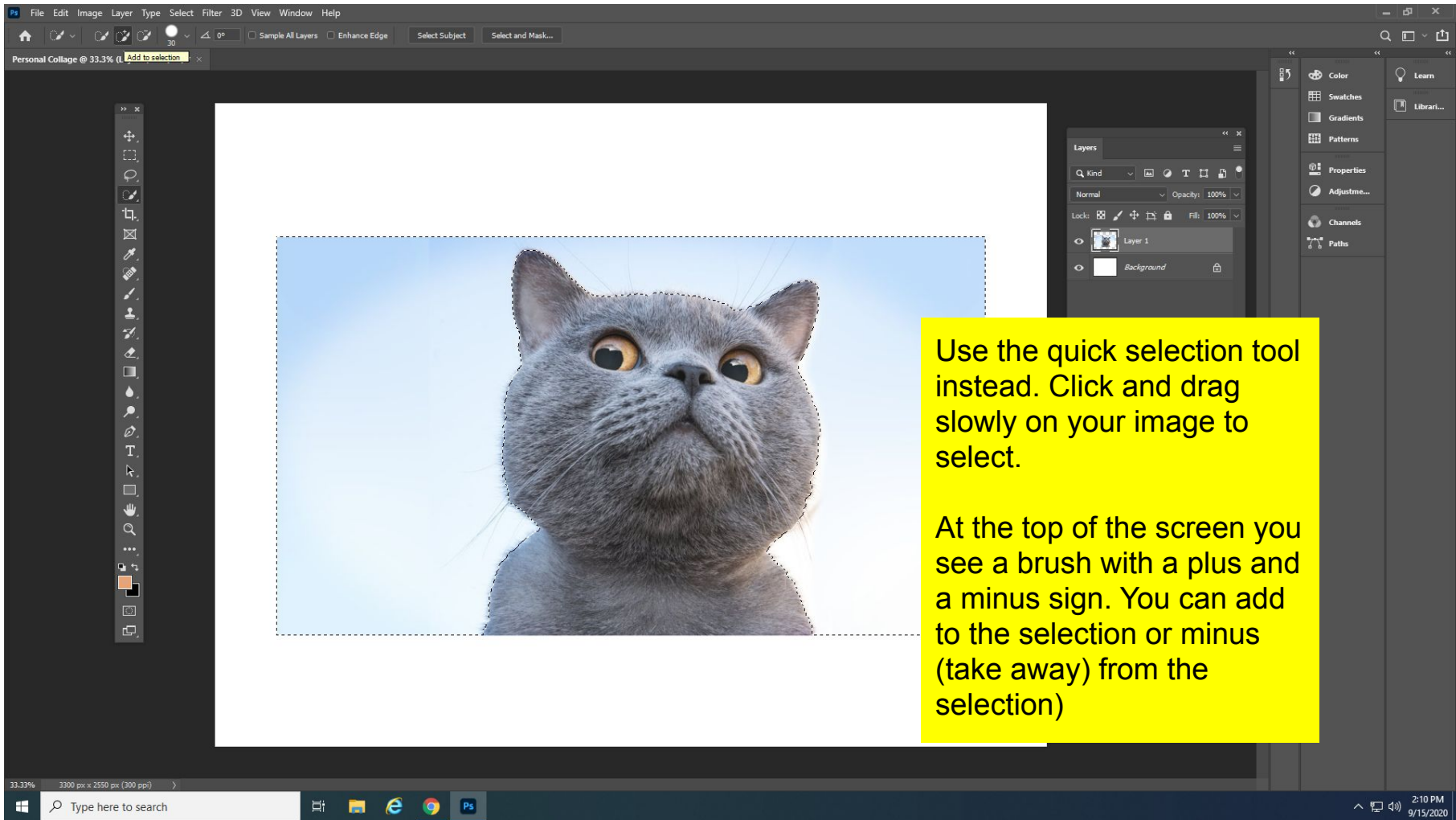


There are several ways to cut out an image from its background.

First, in the 4th toolbar slot from the top if you click and hold on it, this box appears.

It has the magic wand, the quick selection tool and the object selection tool.





Use the quick selection tool instead. Click and drag slowly on your image to select.

At the top of the screen you see a brush with a plus and a minus sign. You can add to the selection or minus (take away) from the selection)

Remember to
press
BACKSPACE on
the keyboard to
erase your
selection.

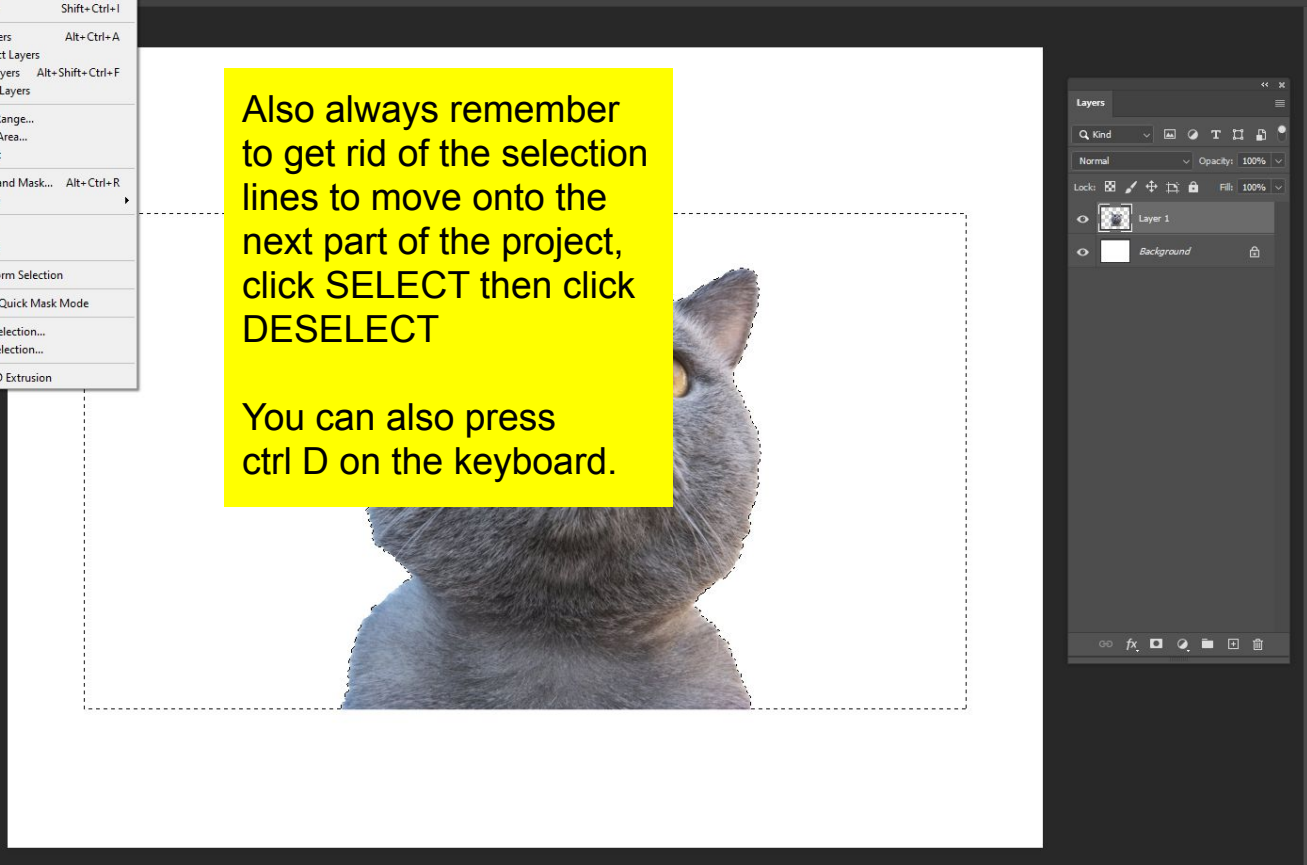

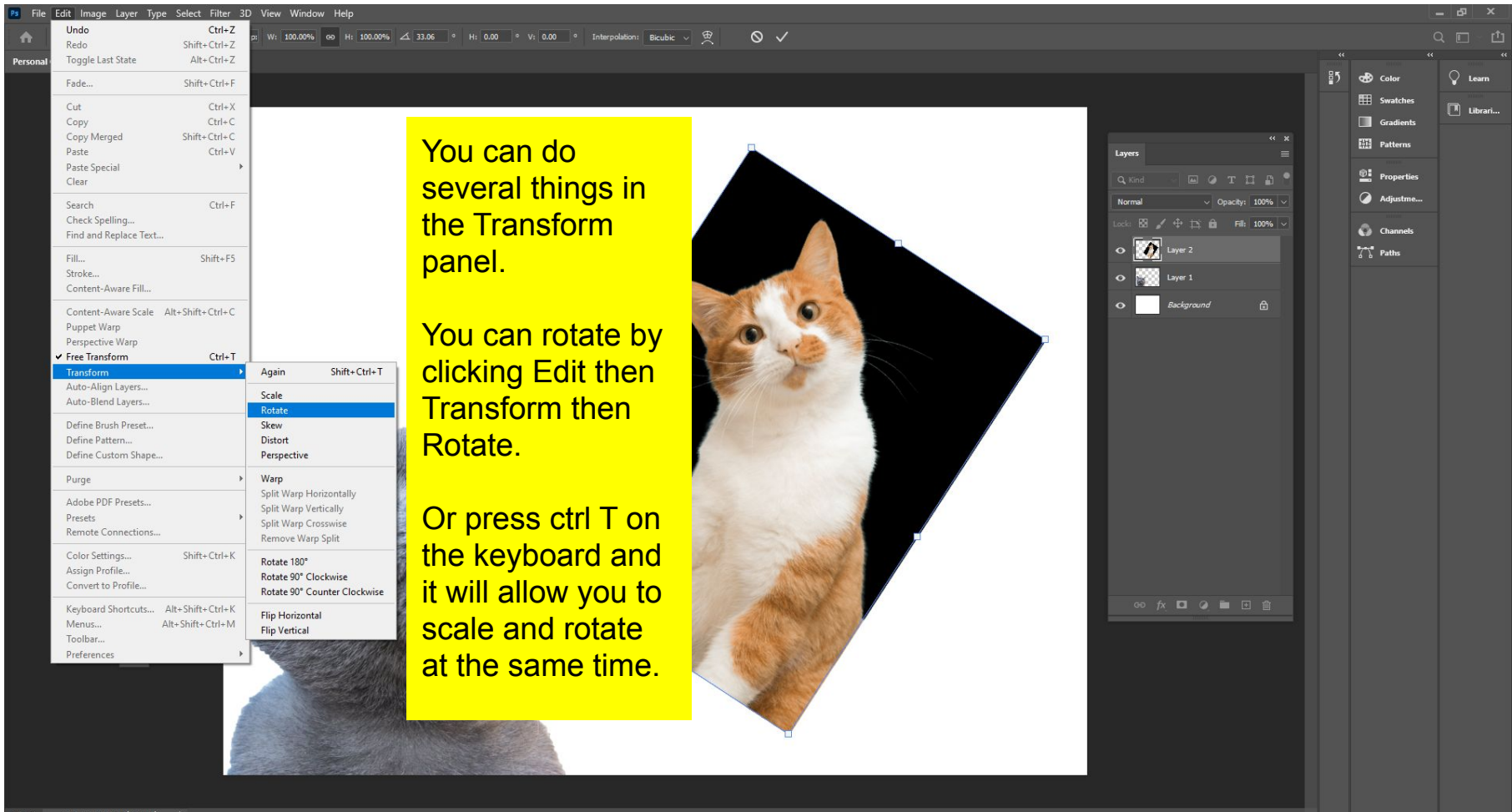

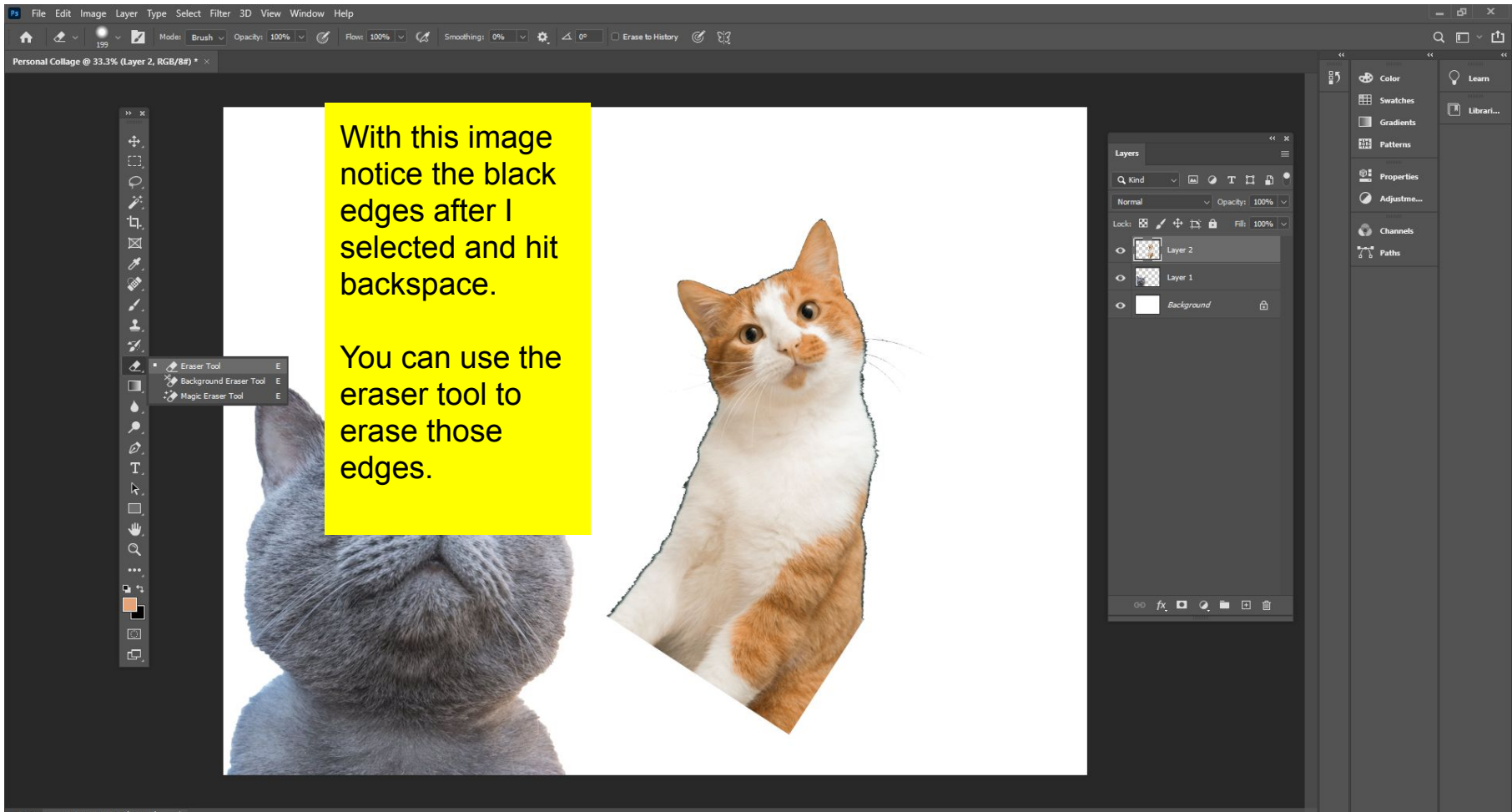

You can do several things in the Transform panel.

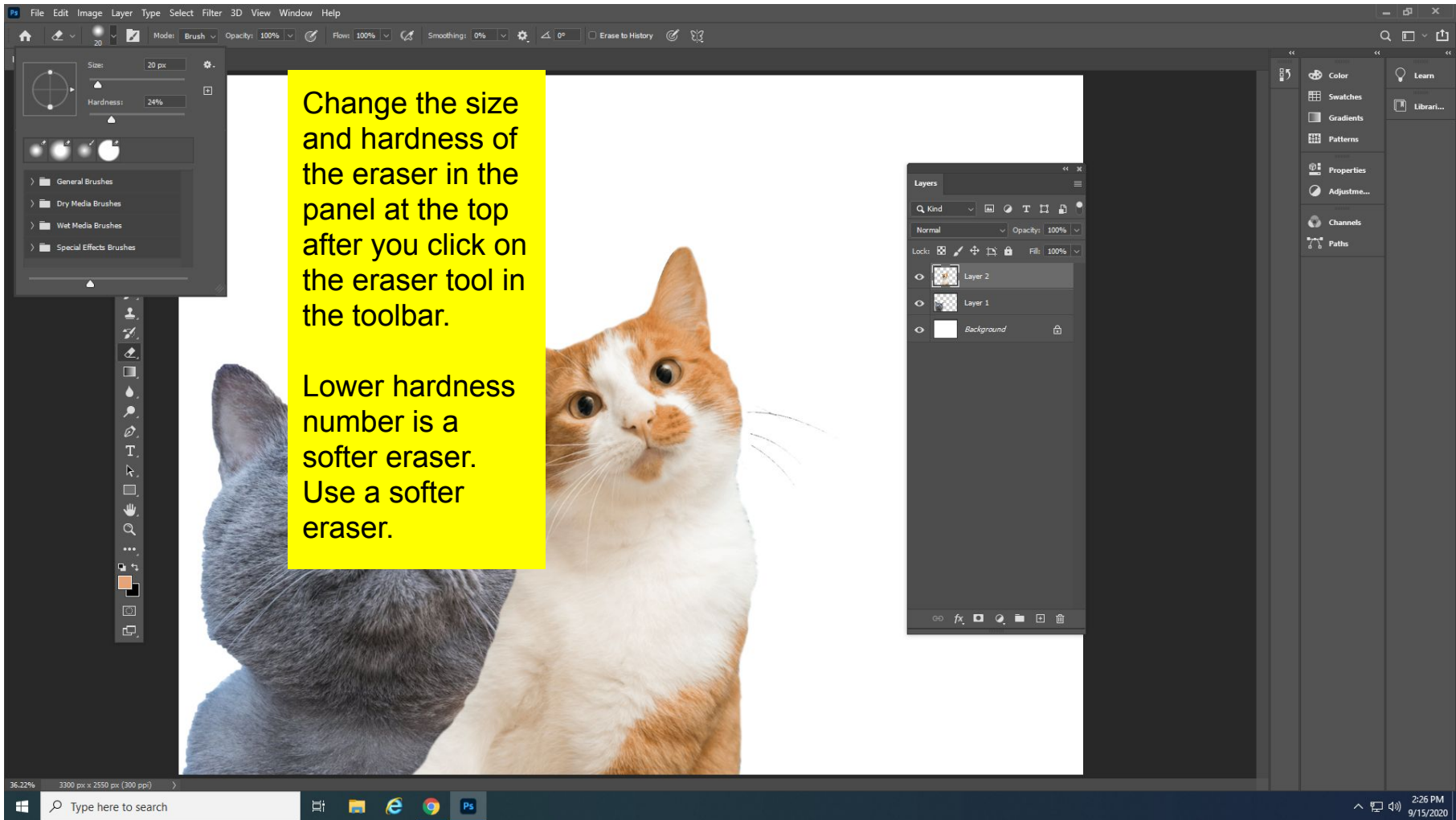
You can rotate by clicking Edit then Transform then Rotate.

Or press ctrl T on the keyboard and it will allow you to scale and rotate at the same time.



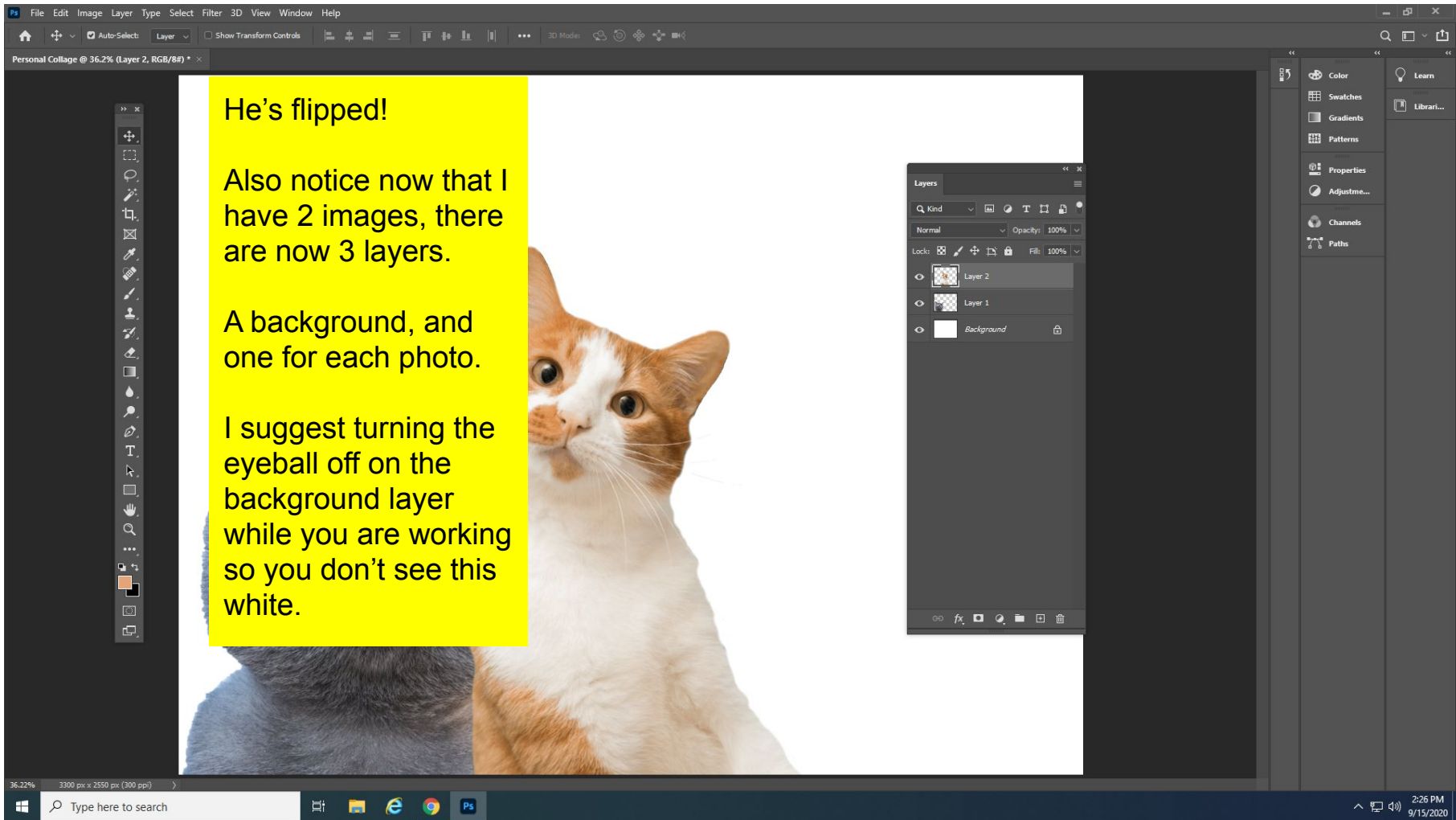
With this image notice the black edges after I selected and hit backspace.

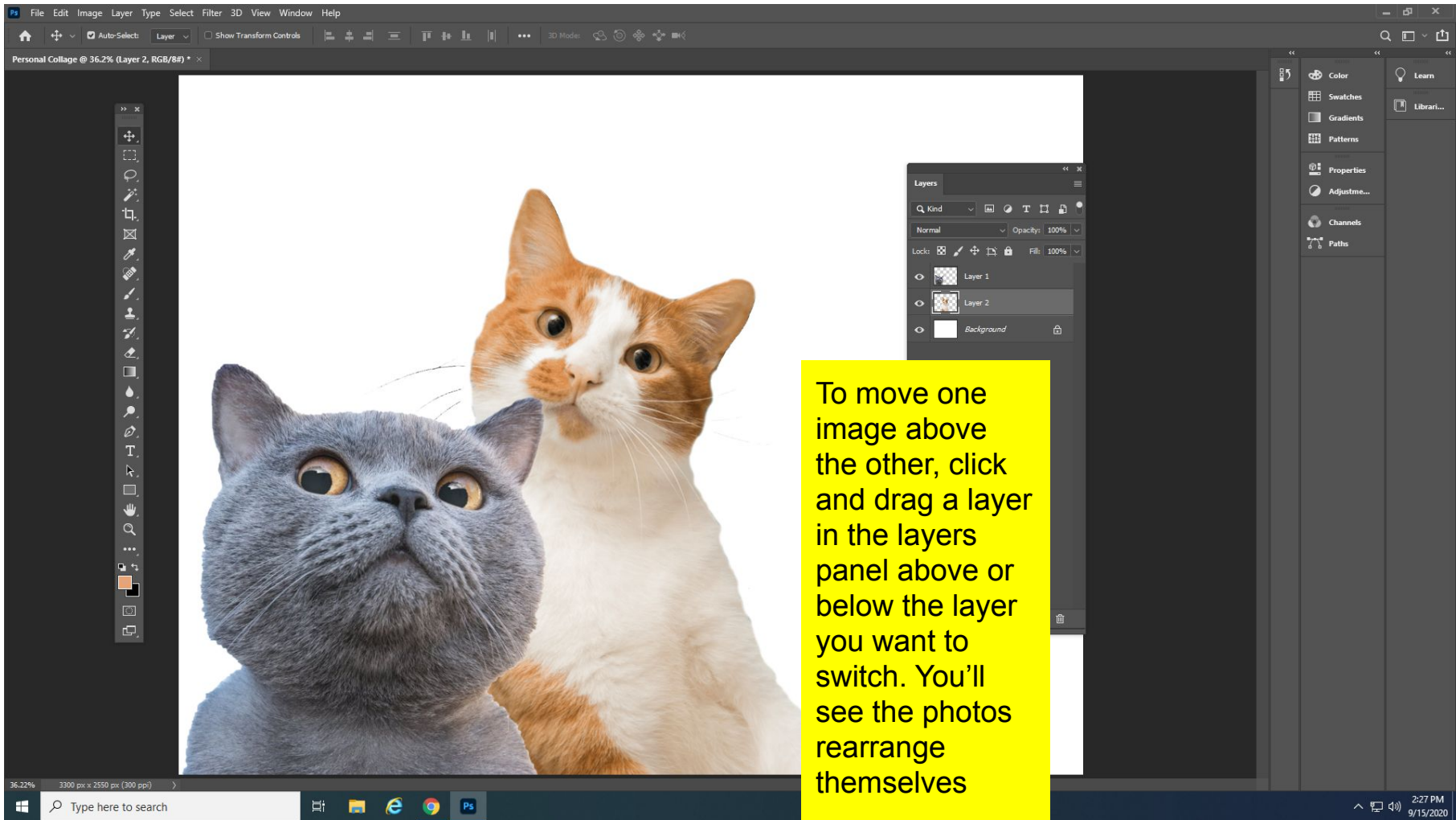
You can use the eraser tool to erase those edges.



Change the size and hardness of the eraser in the panel at the top after you click on the eraser tool in the toolbar.

Lower hardness number is a softer eraser. Use a softer eraser.



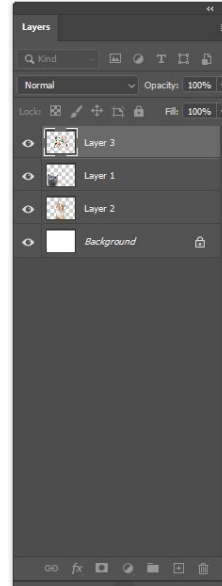
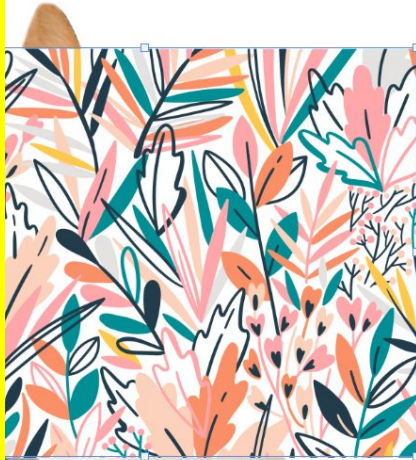


To move one image above the other, click and drag a layer in the layers panel above or below the layer you want to switch. You'll see the photos rearrange themselves

Copy and paste your background into your file. Sometimes it'll paste in small and hidden underneath another layer.

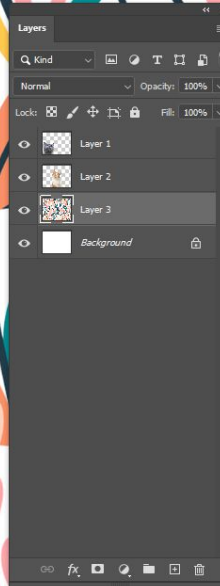
If you can't see it, look at the layers panel for it.

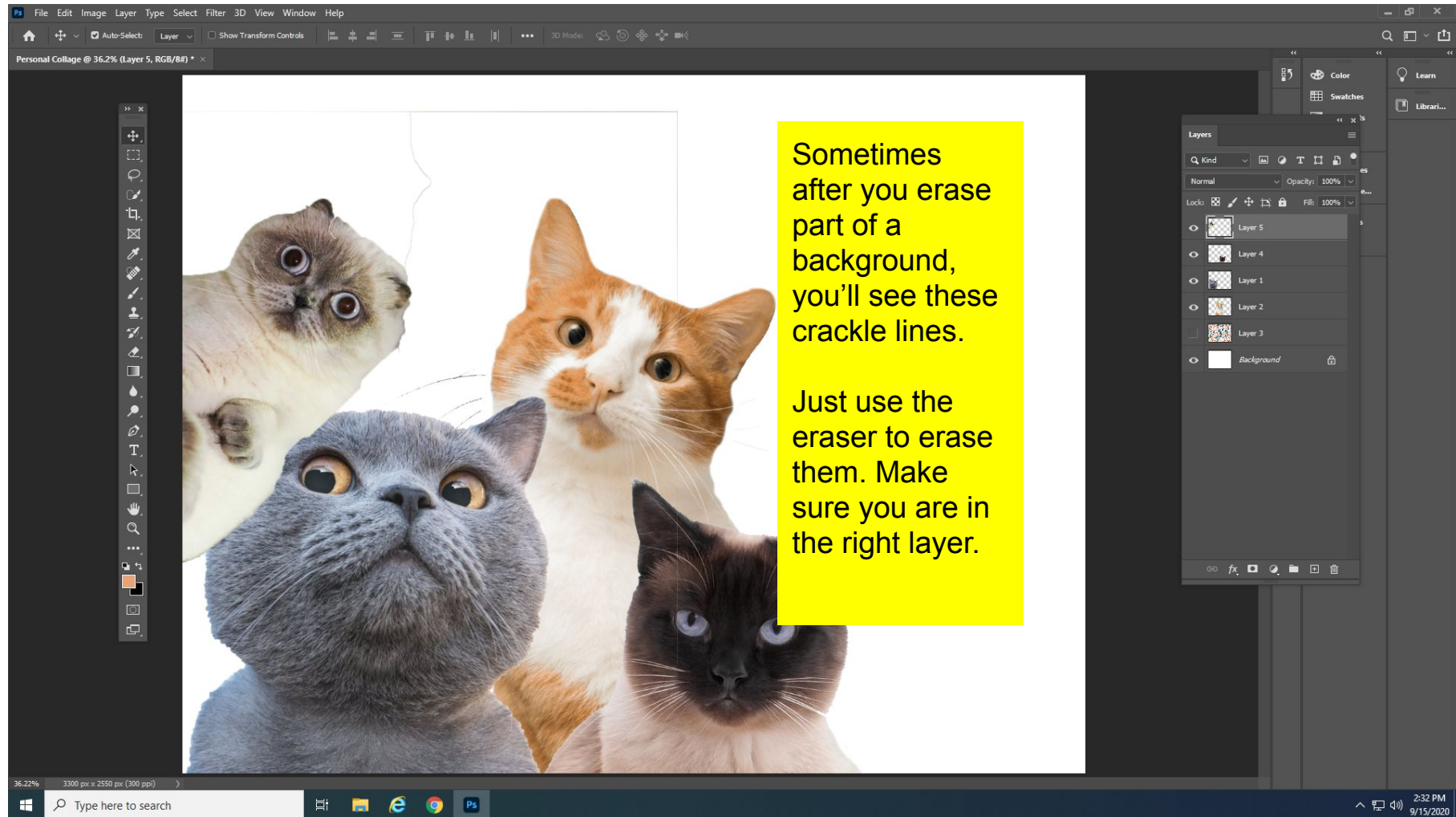
Also you can press ctrl T right after you paste it in and you'll see the resizing box appear around it.



Click and drag that background layer to the back of all the images but above that white background layer.

(You can also just delete the background layer by dragging it to the trash can at the bottom of the layer panel.)





Sometimes after you erase part of a background, you'll see these crackle lines.

Just use the eraser to erase them. Make sure you are in the right layer.



For your personal collage project (FIMA) you need 10 images that represent you in some way.

This is just a tutorial on how to create it. NOT AN EXAMPLE OF A PERSONAL COLLAGE.

So don't just put 10 of the same thing....
