
Flower project

- Legendary painter Vincent Van Gogh (1853 1890) was the unparalleled example of a tormented artistic genius.
- Irises were an iconic component of Van Gogh's body of work. The iris series of paintings were highly emotive, rather than a literal depiction of flowers in an objective sense, and were characterized by strong outlines, atypical angles and non-literal hues. Compelled by the effects of light upon color, Van Gogh created iris paintings, typified by luminous tones and intense, impassioned brushstrokes. He possessed a special gift for capturing the subtleties of light and shadow in his works. Van Gogh relished painting outdoors, and the uplifting effect that nature had upon his fragile psyche. He referred to the painting, "Irises, Saint-Rémy, 1889," as "the lightning conductor for my illness" because he believed he could keep himself sane by persisting to paint.









Choose the ellipse and create colorful circle near each other




After you have created 4 or 3 Choose Filter > Distort > Kaleidoscope




Play with adjustments to create a flower




Create a new layer




Repeat the last 3 slides and create 4 to 5 flowers
