







Now have the stroke panel open, your layers, and change the stroke (the open swatch box at the bottom of the toolbar) to a bright color.


Begin tracing your koi. You only need to trace one



Have the later that has the koi images locked and draw on a later on top.




Drawing eyes. Use the ellipse tool to create the 3 ovals/circles for an eye.



Then select each shape and color each one. Click on the shape then change the swatch (solid box at the bottom of the toolbar) to the desired color.


Then click and drag a selection box around all 3.


Then click Object > Group




Click and drag a selection box around your koi.


## OPEN A NEW PHOTOSHOP FILE 8.5 x 11 INCHES

Copy and paste the koi twice and rotate until it looks like they are swimming.


Then use the magic wand to select the areas you are coloring.






Add in a drop shadow by clicking the fx button at the bottom of the layer panel.
