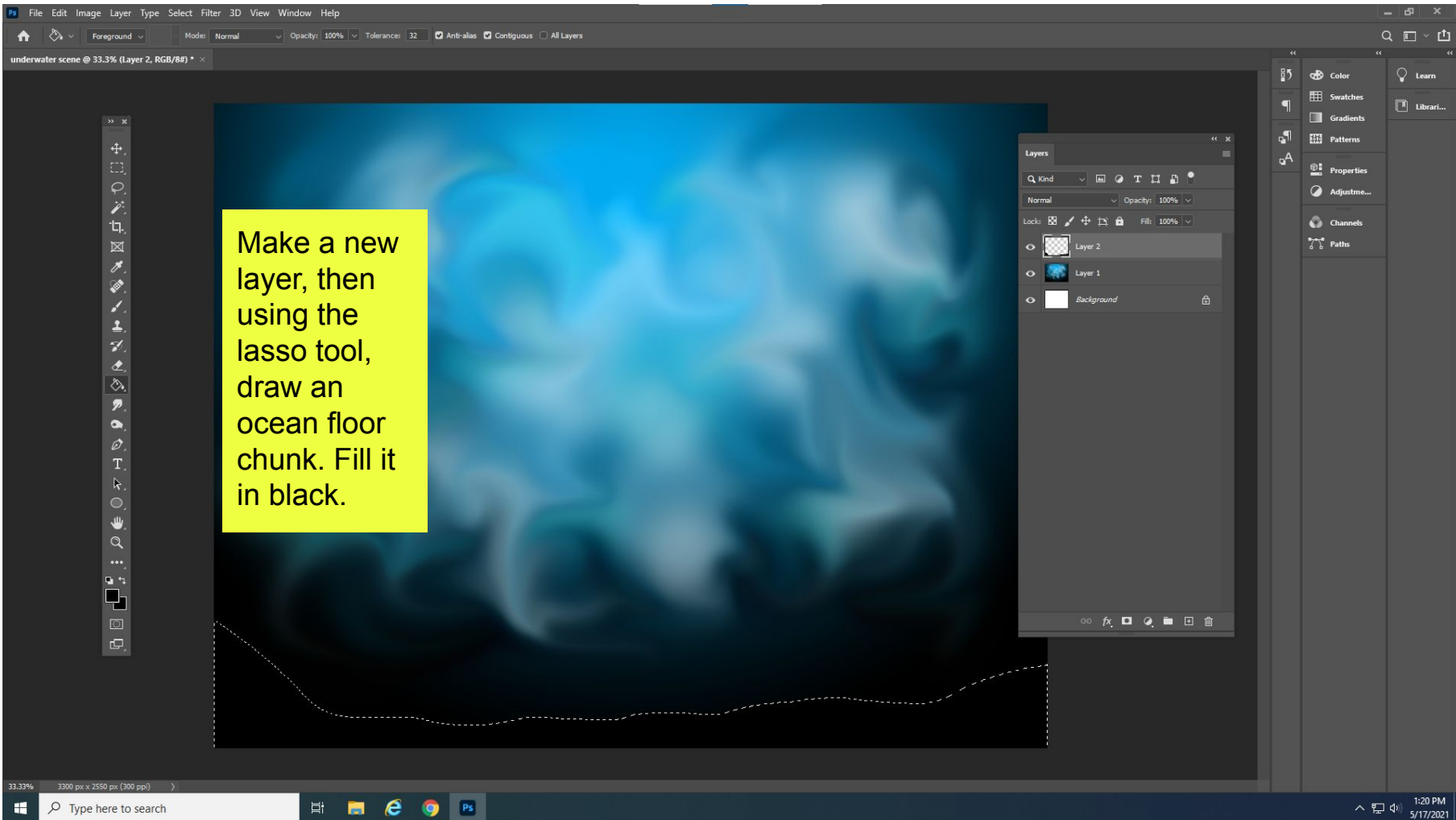




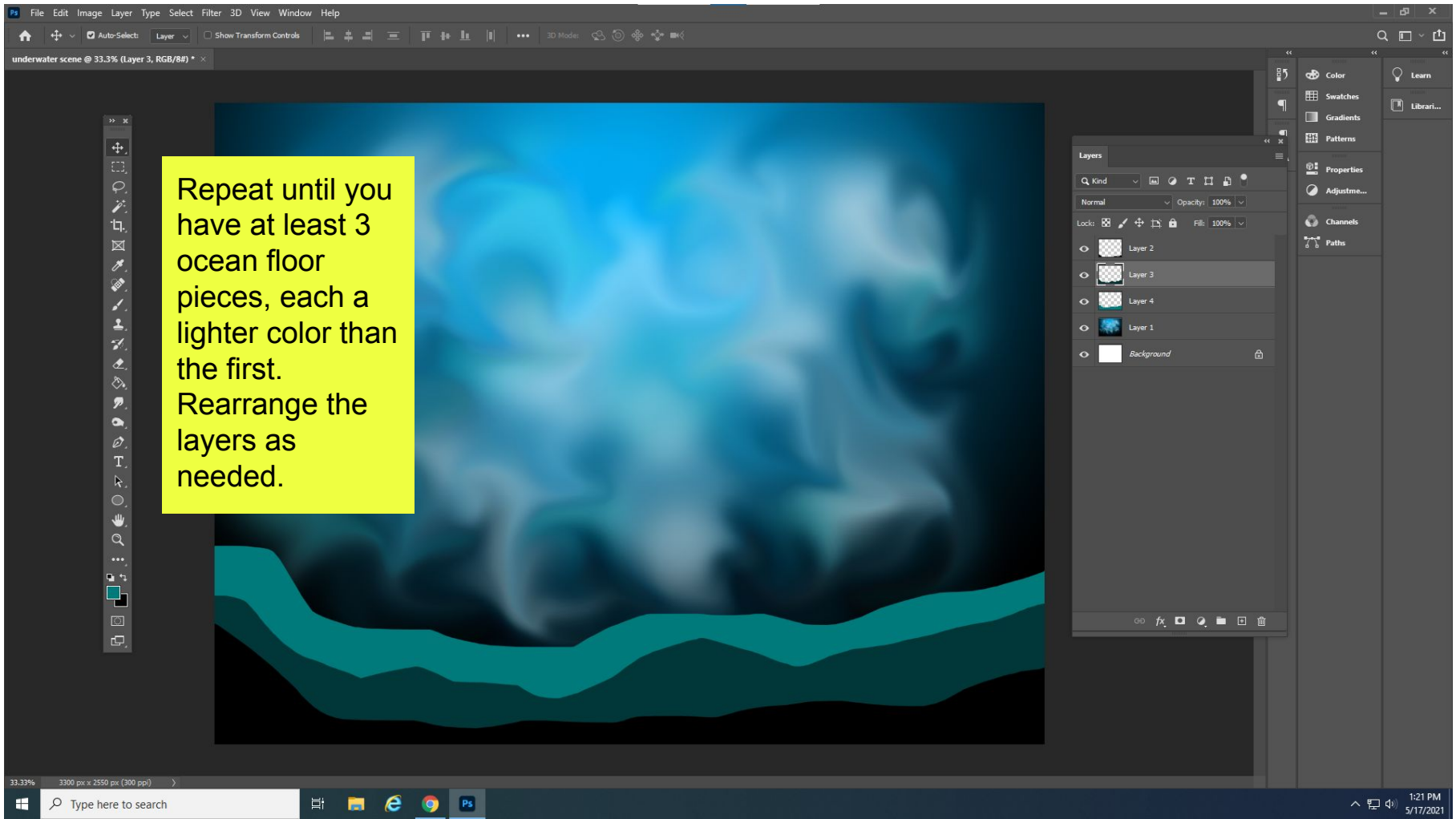
Next, use the brush tool, large size, 30% opacity and 0% hardness to paint in light color blue and white patches of paint
