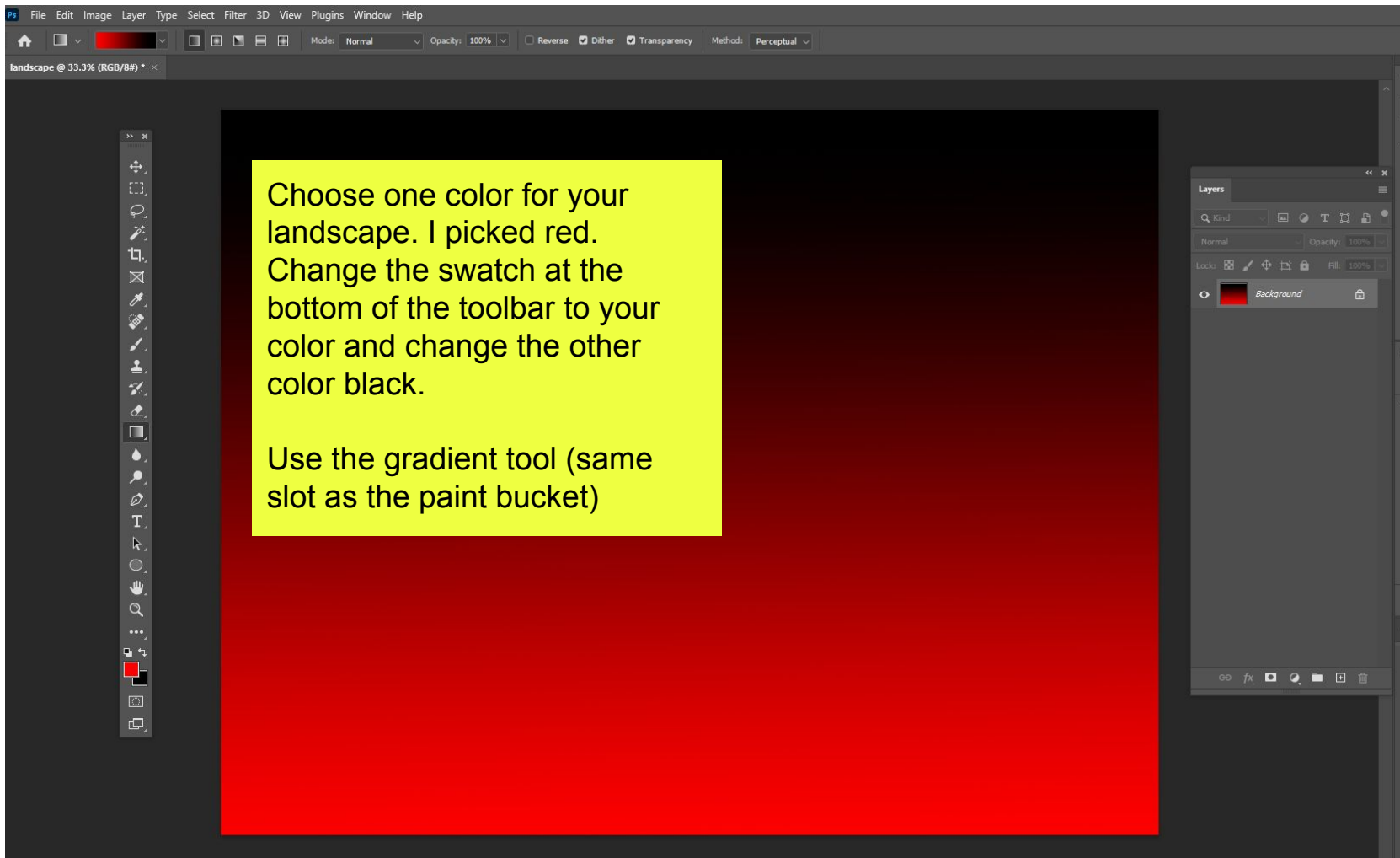

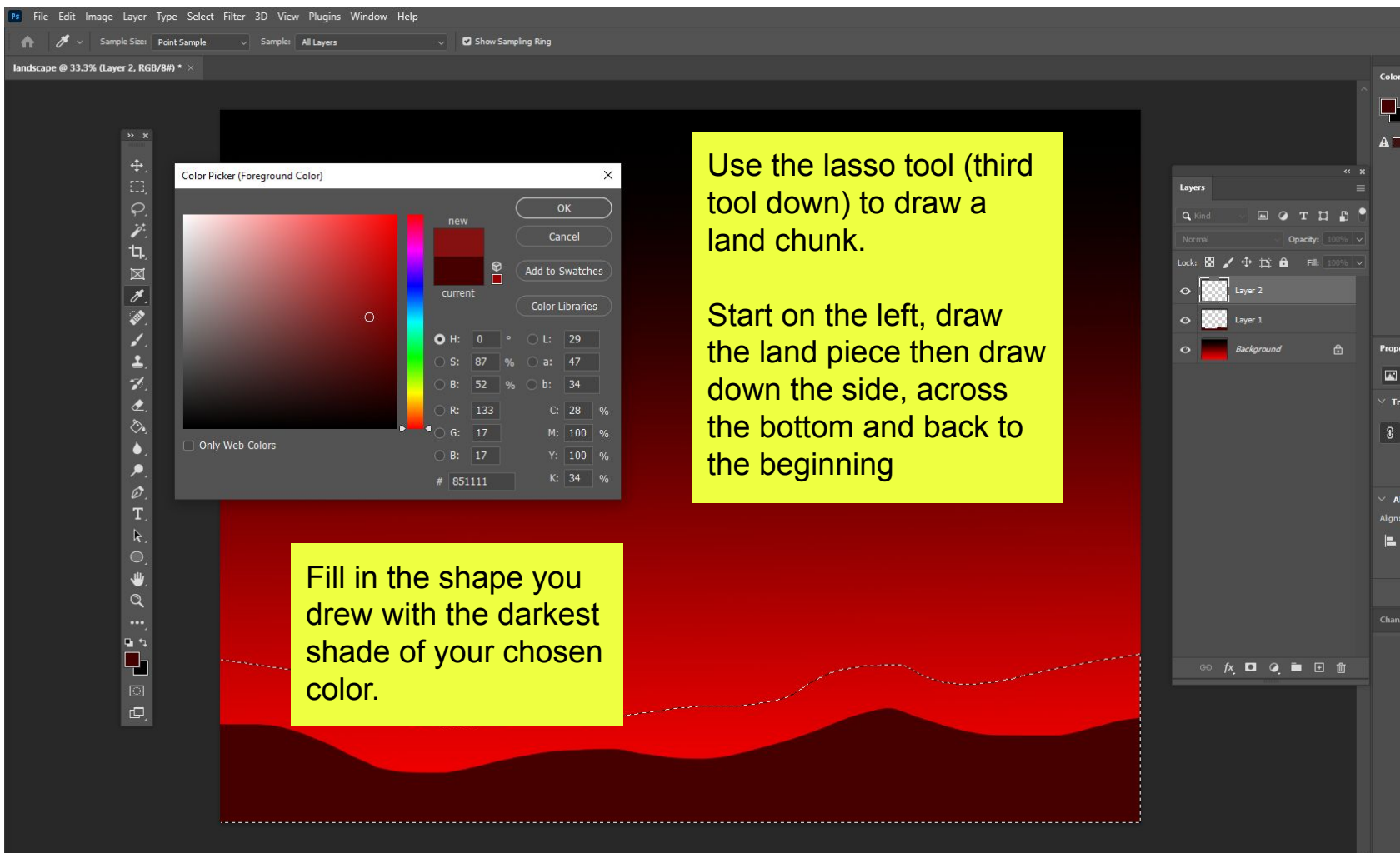

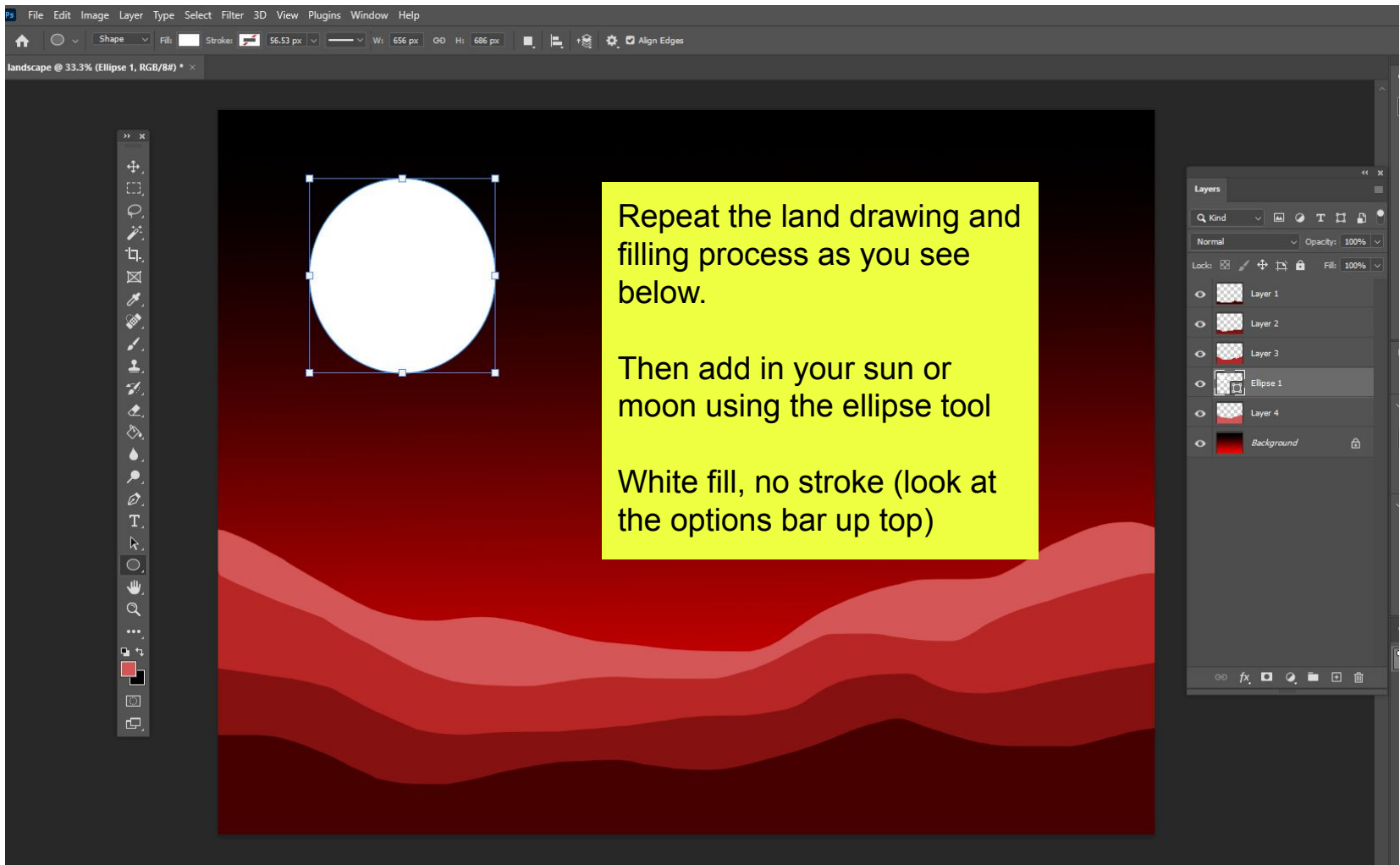
Open Photoshop, new file >

Use the gradient tool (same slot as the paint bucket)

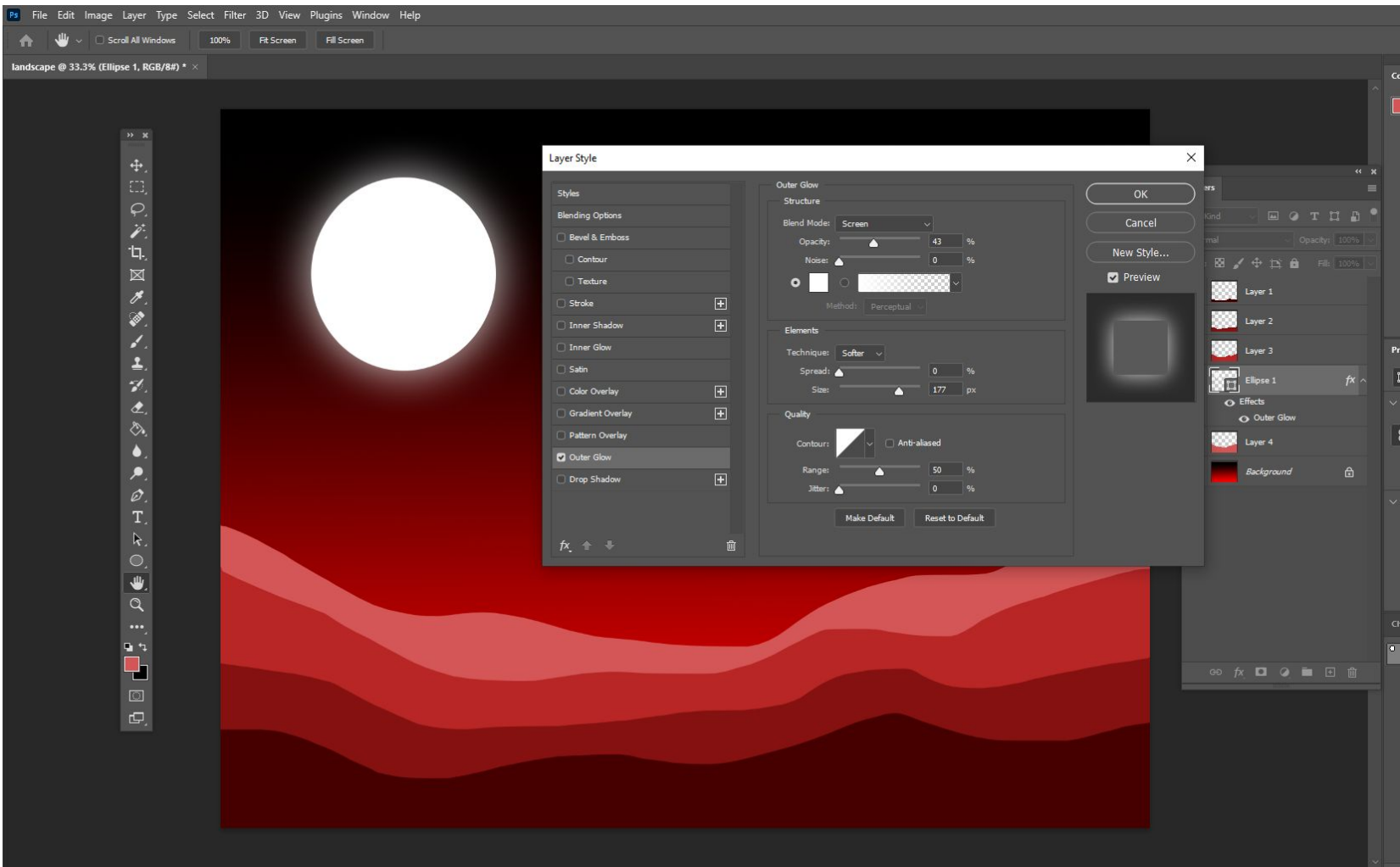


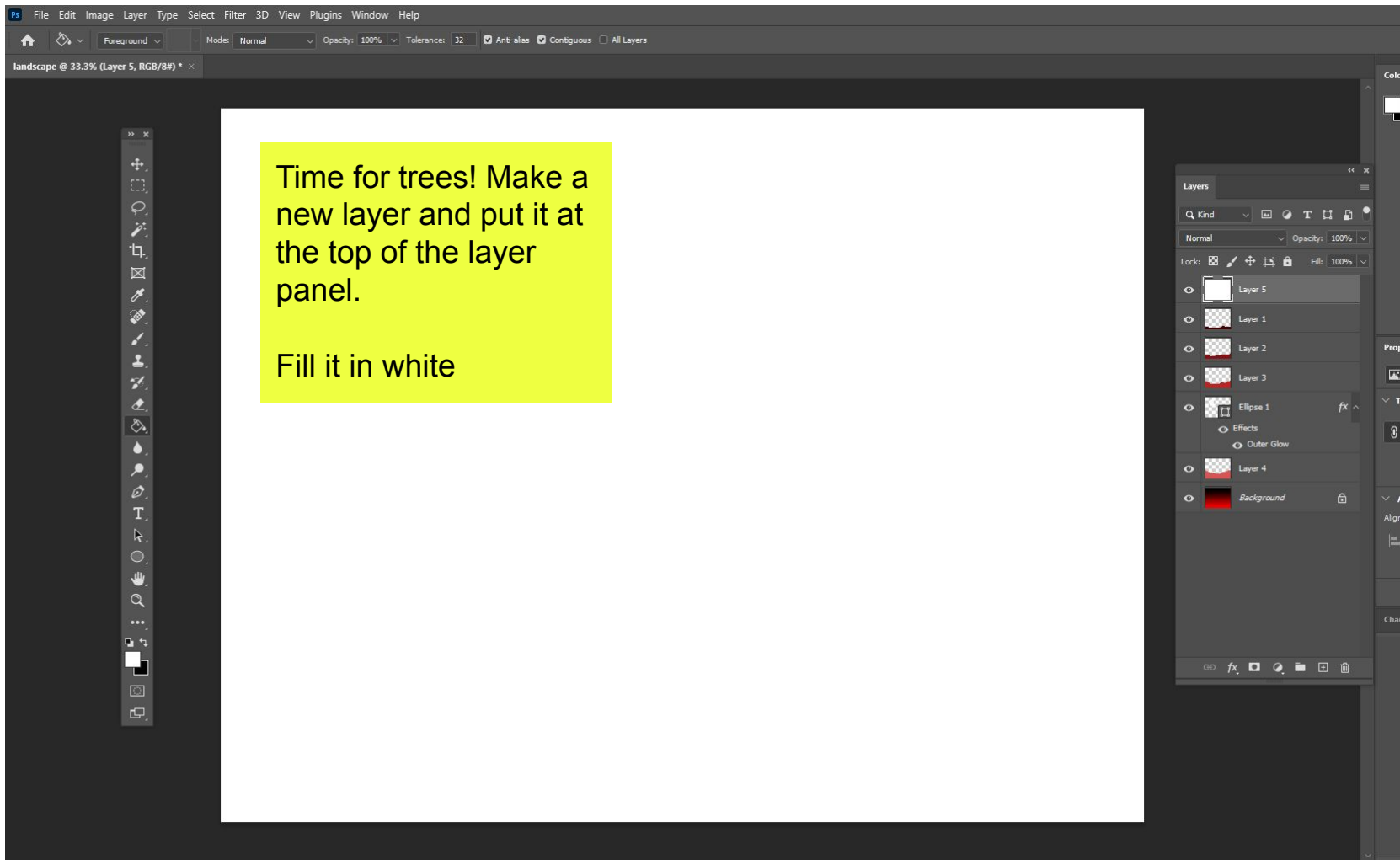


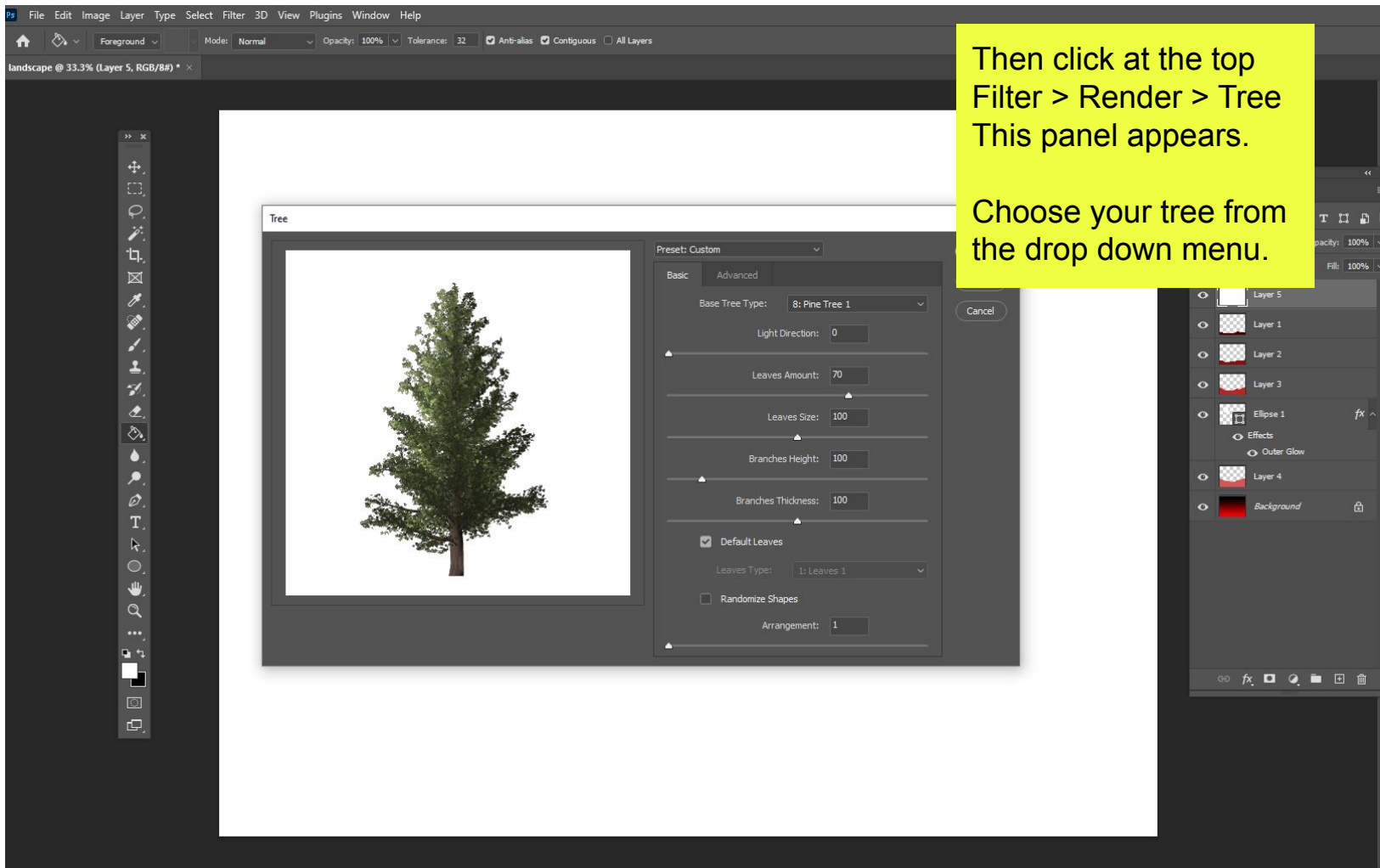
Repeat the land drawing and filling process as you see below.

Then add in your sun or moon using the ellipse tool

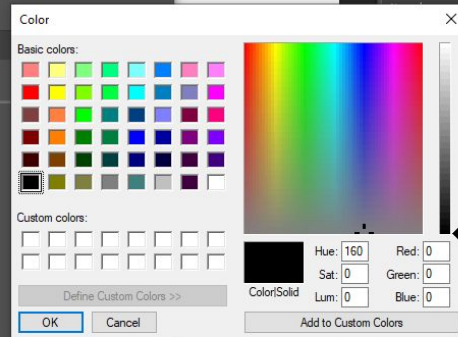

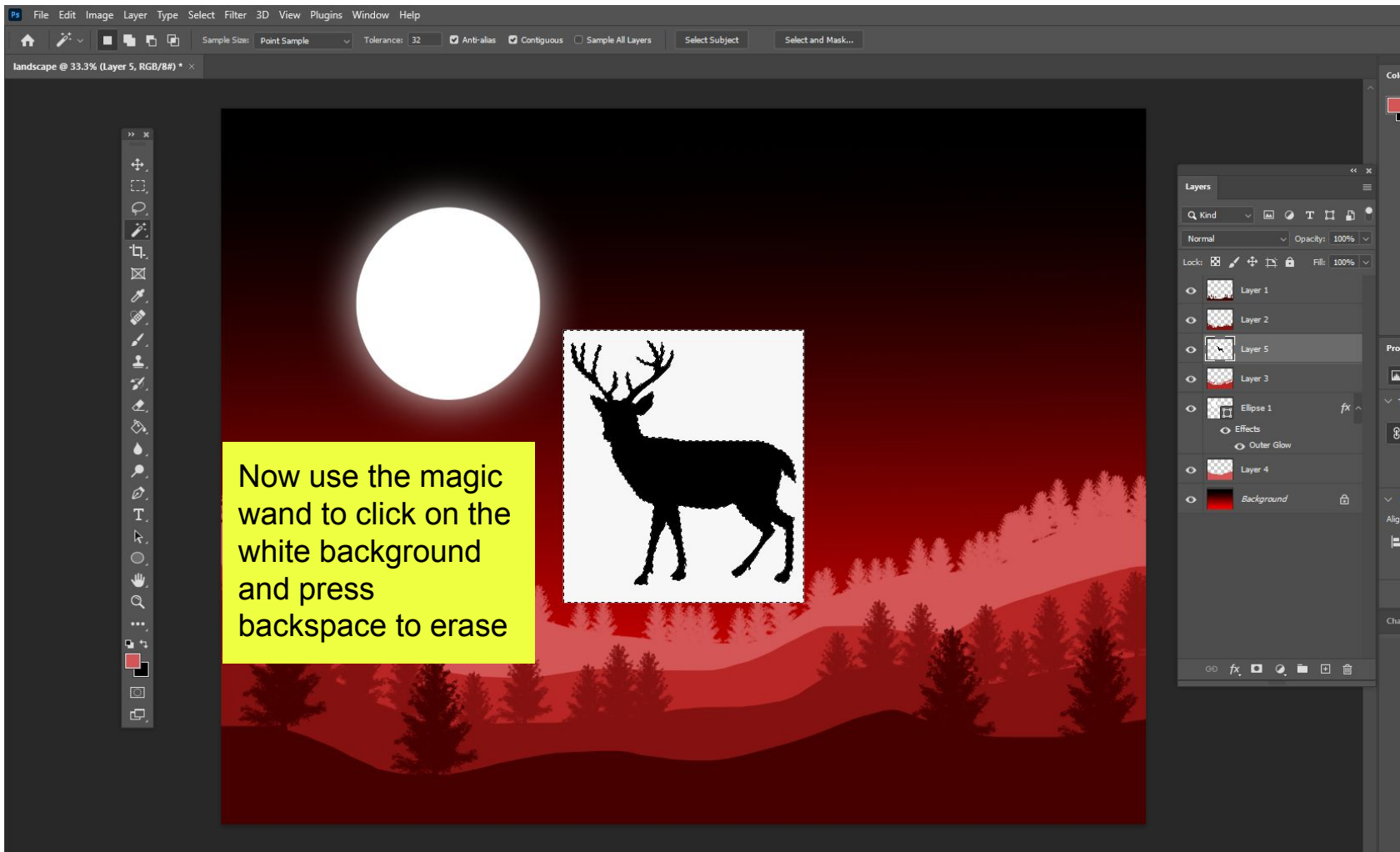
Look up whatever animal, or person, or cabin you want to add a narrative (a story) to your landscape.

- transparent deer silhouette

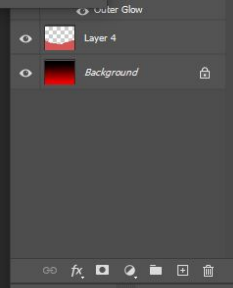
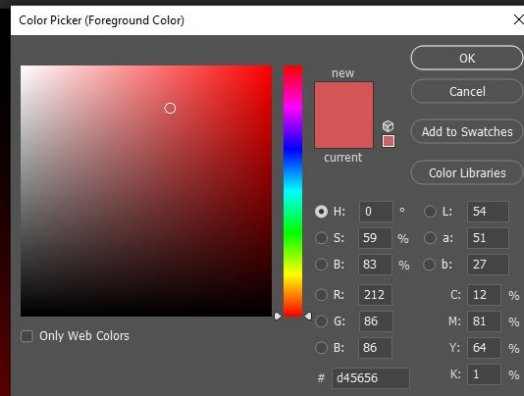


Now use the magic wand to click on the object/ animal

Then use the eyedropper to choose the color of the layer it will stand on.

Then click Edit > Fill > Foreground color (instead of content aware) to color the deer in.

Put it where it is going to go and make it a size that makes sense. Control T
