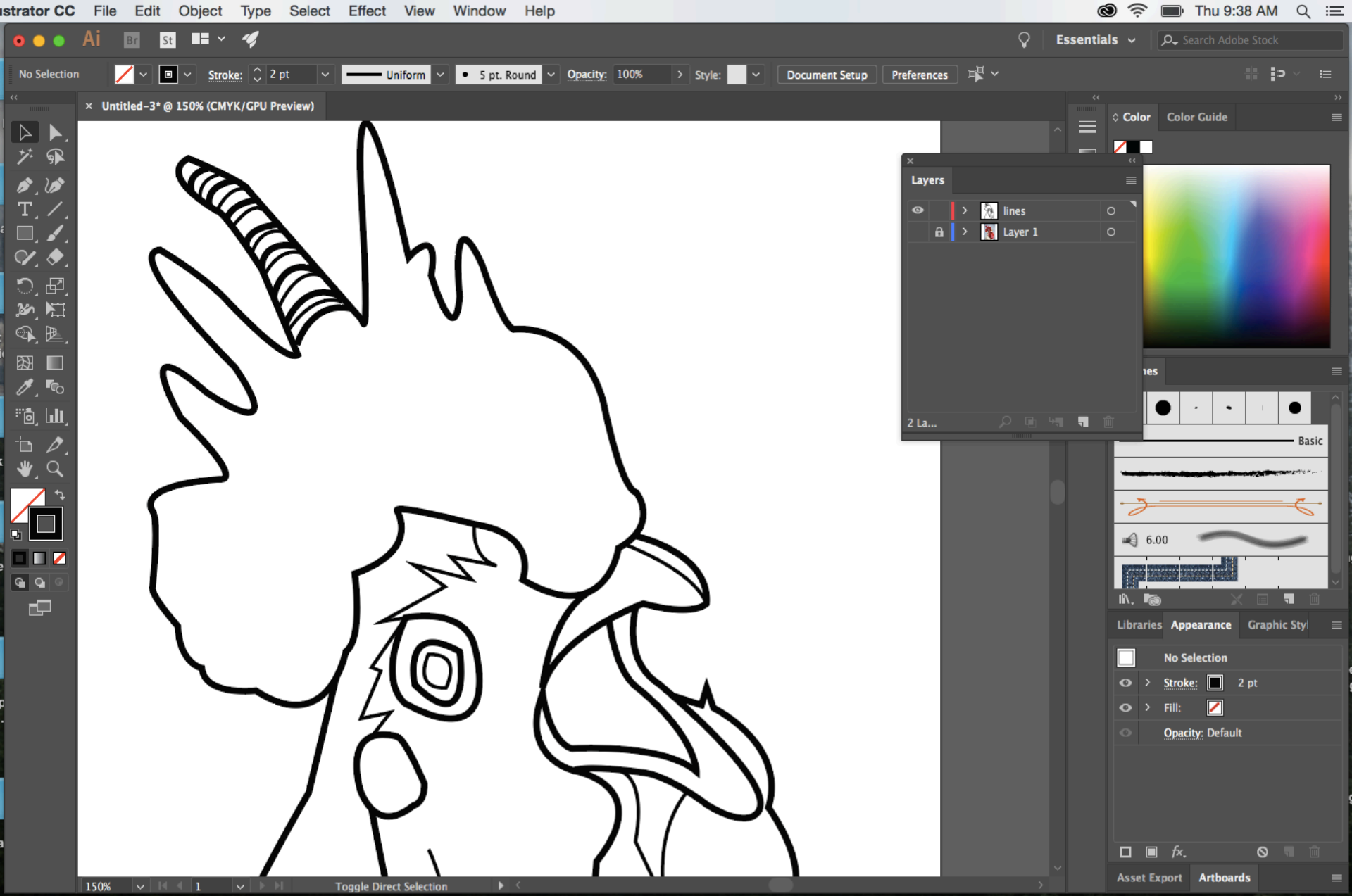
Choose an animal! It can be a portrait or the entire body. You are the artist, you decide.



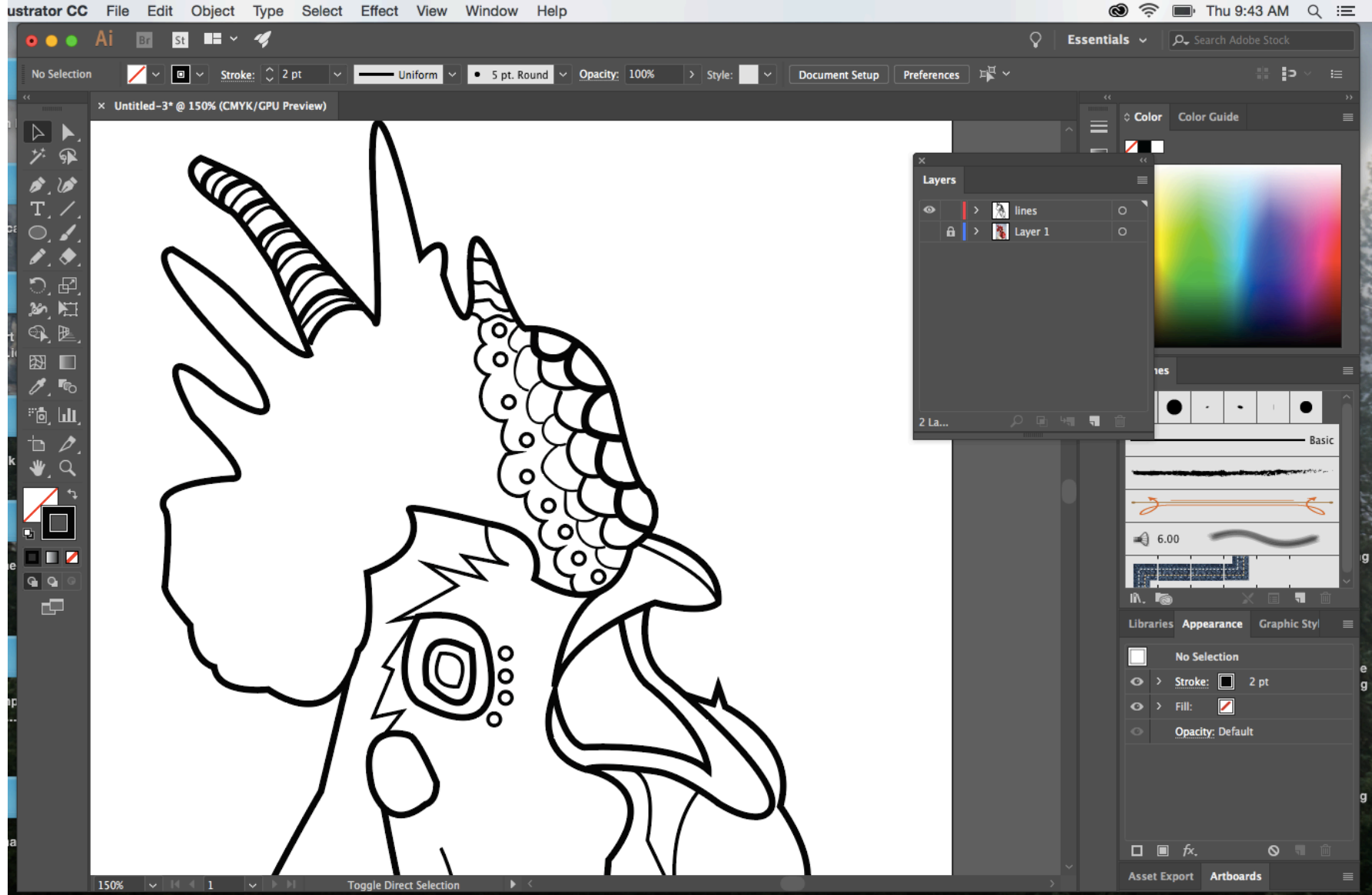
Using the pen tool or the pencil tool, find your contour lines.
Black stroke, no fill. Make the pt size fairly large. I used 4 pt



Turn off the eye on the photo every so often to see your progress.
Choose the best contour lines to describe the way your animal or person looks.



Start adding your patterns! Remember one line at a time. Let it flow from you.



You have a lot of options for creating your lines. Pen tool, pencil tool, brush tool and any of the shape tools. Use a combination of all these tools to build up your patterns.



Make sure your entire animal or person is entirely filled with patterns.

Vary your stroke pt size and style as you go.

If you created complete shapes with the pen tool, feel free to fill them with black as needed.
